

AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH THE RATES OF TAXATION TO BE LEVIED ON TAXABLE REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY IN THE CITY OF CAMMACK VILLAGE, ARKANSAS FOR THE TAX YEAR 2001; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMMACK VILLAGE:

Section 1: The tax rate for general purposes to be levied on all taxable real property as of the assessment date of January 1, 2001 in Cammack Village, Pulaski County, Arkansas for the tax year 2001 shall be 5.0 mills as applied to assessed valuation.

Section 2: The tax rate for general purposes to be levied on all taxable personal property as of the assessment date of January 1, 2001 in Cammack Village, Pulaski County, Arkansas for the tax year 2001 shall be 5.0 mills as applied to assessed valuation.

Section 3: All ordinances or resolutions in conflict herewith are specifically repealed.

EMERGENCY CLAUSE. The City Council for the City of Cammack Village finds and determines that an ordinance adopting the rates of taxation to be levied on taxable real and personal property is necessary for the orderly administration and operation of the City of Cammack Village, Arkansas; and that an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect on or after the _____ day of _____, 2001.
