

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE NECESSITY OF
HOMEOWNERS TO PROPERLY DISPLAY A STREET
ADDRESS NUMBER SO IT MAY BE VISIBLE FROM THE
STREET AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

Section 1: It shall be required by residents in Cammack Village, Arkansas that a street address number be properly displayed in such a manner that it may be clearly visible from the street on which the home is located.

Section 2: Violations. Any person found to be in violation of this ordinance shall be fined \$25.00 per day for non-compliance.

Section 3: Any ordinance or parts thereof found to be in conflict herewith are repealed to the extent of the conflict.


Section 4: Any part of this ordinance declared void or unconstitutional shall not affect the remaining parts of the ordinance.

Section 5: Emergency Clause. The City Council for the City of Cammack Village finds and determines that the failure to display an adequate street address to enable police and emergency vehicles to properly identify the home in which assistance is being rendered is necessary. The proper display is essential for the orderly administration and operation of the City of Cammack Village. An emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect on or after the 9th day of July, 2002.
