

ORDINANCE 06-03

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING RESIDENTS TO REMOVE TRASH CONTAINERS FROM THE STREET IN A TIMELY MANNER, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Cammack Village deems it necessary and appropriate to require residents to timely remove trash containers from the street after trash pickup.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ordained by the City Council of the City of Cammack Village, Arkansas:

SECTION 1: Trash Containers and recycling bins shall be removed from the street no later than twenty-four hours following the time trash is picked up by the City, (or its agents). Trash containers and recycling bins should be stored in a location no closer to the street than the front edge of the residents home in a location that may not be easily be observed from the street.

SECTION 2: Violation of this ordinance shall result in a warning being delivered to the resident for a first violation. Subsequent violations shall result in a citation being issued by the City to the resident failing to remove the trash container or recycling bin.

SECTION 3: Persons found to be in violation of this Ordinance shall be fined \$100 for each offense.

SECTION 4: This ordinance repeals any prior Ordinances to the extent such other Ordinance is in conflict with this Ordinance as to any part.

SECTION 5: Emergency Clause: The City Council for the City of Cammack Village finds and determines that an emergency is declared to exist, and this Ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public

peace, health and safety be in full force and effect on and after March 14, 2006
