

ORDINANCE 06-06

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING 99-6 WHICH REGULATES THE SPEED OF VEHICLES ON THE STREETS OF THE CITY OF CAMMACK VILLAGE, DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Cammack Village previously adopted Ordinance No. 99-6 to regulate the speed of vehicles on the streets of the city of Cammack Village and to prescribe penalties for the violation thereof;

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend Ordinance No. 99-6 with this ordinance to change time periods for the 20 mph speed limit in the designated school zone area.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMMACK VILLAGE, ARKANSAS, TO WIT:


SECTION 1: Section 1b of Ordinance No. 99-6 shall be amended as follows: the 20 mph speed limit on North McKinley between the intersections of Brentwood and Waverly shall be in effect only at such times as children are present in the school zone. Generally, such times are when Jefferson school is in session and such times as school events occur. Signs shall be posted informing motorists of the 20 mph speed limit in the manner prescribed by state law.

EMERGENCY CLAUSE: The City Council for the City of Cammack Village finds and determines that amending Ordinance No. 99-6 is essential for the orderly administration and operation of the City of Cammack Village, Arkansas and an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety be in full force and effect on and after August 8, 2006.
