

ORDINANCE NO. 06-10

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THAT ALL OPERATORS OF
MOTORIZED VEHICLES BE PROPERLY LICENSED;
PROVIDING FOR PENALTIES; PROVIDING FOR AN
EMERGENCY CLAUSE AND OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Cammack Village deems it necessary to require
that all operators of motorized vehicles on the city streets of Cammack Village be
licensed drivers pursuant to the laws of the state of Arkansas:

Now, therefore, be it resolved that:

Section 1:

In order for a person to operate a motor vehicle of any kind on the streets of
Cammack Village, Arkansas, it will be necessary for the operator to have a valid
Arkansas driver's license. A motor vehicle is defined as any vehicle propelled by
electricity or internal combustion engine.

Section 2:

Persons found to be in violation of this ordinance shall be fined the sum of up to
\$100 plus court costs.


Section 3: EMERGENCY CLAUSE: The City Council for the City of Cammack
Village finds and determines that it is necessary to have a valid driver's license to
operate a motor vehicle on the streets of Cammack Village and this ordinance is
essential for the orderly administration and operation of the City of Cammack
Village, Arkansas and an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance being
necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety be in full force
and effect on and after October 10, 2006.
