

ORDINANCE NO. 06-13

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE AMENDMENT OF CERTAIN PORTIONS OF ORDINANCE NO. 95-24, WHICH PROVIDES FOR THE PREVENTION OF UNSANITARY CONDITIONS WITHIN THE CITY OF CAMMACK VILLAGE, ARKANSAS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Cammack Village previously adopted Ordinance No. 95-24 dealing with the prevention of unsanitary conditions within the City of Cammack Village; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend Ordinance 95-24 to provide for an increase in fines and to include within the definition of proscribed conduct the deposit of leaves and other yard debris in or upon public streets, sidewalks, or other public places within the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Cammack Village does enact and ordain this Ordinance as follows:

SECTION A: The following portions of Ordinance No. 95-24 shall be amended as follows:

- i. The minimum fine provided within Section 2 shall be the sum of no less than \$25 and the maximum fine shall be no more than \$100.
- ii. Section 5 shall be amended to provide that "in no event shall any single lot, tract or parcel of land be assessed a charge of less than \$100."
- iii. Section 6 shall be amended to read as follows, "It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, or corporation to throw, drop, place or otherwise deposit any paper, hand bills, cans, bottles, or other trash, refuse, junk, garbage, litter, leaves, and/or any other form of yard debris or waste upon any street, sidewalk, or other public places within the city or upon any private property within the city, except in public receptacles or in authorized private receptacles for collection."
- iv. Section 8 shall be amended to provide for an increase in the minimum fine of not less than \$25 and a maximum fine of no more than \$100.


SECTION B: All other portions of Ordinance No. 95-24 not in conflict with these amendments are hereby incorporated within the terms of this Ordinance and restated word for word.

SECTION C: It is found and determined that this Ordinance is necessary for the health and public safety of the residents of the City of Cammack Village and that yard waste and other debris continues to constitute an unsanitary and unsightly nuisance to the residents of the City of Cammack Village; that the provisions providing for fines for violations of this Ordinance have not curbed said behavior: and some persons continue to deliberately place yard waste on the public streets of Cammack Village; therefore, an emergency does exist and that this Ordinance shall be in effect and full force immediately upon its adoption by the City Council of the City of Cammack Village.
