

ORDINANCE 10-10

AN ORDINANCE REVISING ORDINANCE 09-08 TO AMEND THE APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JANUARY 1, 2010 THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2010 FROM THE GENERAL FUND FROM THE AMOUNT OF \$465,156 TO THE AMOUNT OF \$511,260; FROM THE AMOUNT OF \$220,015.20 TO THE AMOUNT OF \$223,000 FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT; FROM THE AMOUNT OF \$3761.80 TO \$12,000 FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT; THE AMOUNT OF \$82,010 FOR THE SANITATION DEPARTMENT; THE AMOUNT OF \$16,250 FOR THE PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT (EXCLUDING SWIMMING POOL); FROM THE AMOUNT OF \$5,000 TO THE AMOUNT OF \$22,000 FOR THE SWIMMING POOL FUND; FROM THE AMOUNT OF \$132,619 TO \$143,000 FOR THE ADMINISTRATION DEPARTMENT; FROM THE AMOUNT OF \$5,500 TO THE AMOUNT OF \$6,000 FOR SALES TAX; ALL PREVIOUSLY DESIGNATED DEPARTMENTAL FUNDS APPROPRIATED FROM THE GENERAL FUND; AN APPROPRIATION FROM THE STREET FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$58,930; AN AMENDED APPROPRIATION FROM THE SWIMMING POOL FUND FROM THE AMOUNT OF \$62,700 TO THE AMOUNT OF \$66,000; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND FOR ALL OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend the funds to be used for the operation of the various departments of the City of Cammack Village for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2010 and ending December 31, 2010.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Cammack Village, Arkansas;

SECTION 1: That funds for the fiscal year, beginning January 1, 2010, and ending December 31, 2010, are hereby amended and appropriated from the General Fund, Pool Fund and Street Funds in the amount and for the departments as hereinafter set forth.
