ORDINANCE 10-11

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JANUARY 1, 2011, THROUGH DECEMBER 31, 2011 FROM THE GENERAL FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$476,400; THE SUM OF \$220,937 FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT; THE SUM OF \$141,541 FOR THE ADMINISTRATION DEPARTMENT; THE SUM OF \$4,262 FOR THE FIRE DEPARTMENT; THE SUM OF \$82,410 FOR THE SANITATION DEPARTMENT; THE SUM OF \$16,750 FOR THE PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT (EXCLUDING THE SWIMMING POOL); THE SUM OF \$5,000 FOR THE SWIMMING POOL; THE SUM OF \$5,500 FOR THE SALES TAX; ALL FUNDS APPROPRIATED FROM THE GENERAL FUND; AN APPROPRIATION FROM THE STREET FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$60,930, AND AN APPROPRIATION FROM THE SWIMMING POOL FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$54,800; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND FOR ALL OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate funds to be used for the operation of the various departments of the City of Cammack Village for the fiscal year beginning January 1, 2011 and ending December 31, 2011.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED by the City Council of the City of Cammack Village, Arkansas;

SECTION 1: That funds for the fiscal year, beginning January 1, 2011, and ending December 31, 2011, are hereby amended and appropriated from the General Fund, Pool Fund and Street Funds in the amount and for the departments as hereinafter set forth.
