

**ORDINANCE 12-01**

**AN ORDINANCE TO REVISE AND ESTABLISH THE SALARIES OF CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF CAMMACK VILLAGE, ESTABLISHING HOLIDAY COMPENSATION POLICIES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Cammack Village deems it necessary and appropriate to revise and establish maximum annual salaries and maximum hourly rates per hour for certain employees of the City of Cammack Village and set official holidays and compensation policies for employees of the City of Cammack Village, Arkansas.

**NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMMACK VILLAGE, ARKANSAS:**

**Section 1: Maximum Salary Schedule.** The following is established as the maximum schedule for employees of the City of Cammack Village (not including any fringe benefits):

Marshal (1)	\$45,168.00	Per Year
Administrative Assistant (1)	\$33,000.00	Per Year
Administrative Clerk (1)	\$8.50	Per Hour
Full Time Patrolman (3)	\$31,000.00	Per Year
Part Time/Overtime Patrolman	\$15.00	Per Hour
Summer Pool Employees	\$8.25	Per Hour
Summer Pool Concession Workers	\$7.50	Per Hour
Summer Pool Manager	\$5,500.00	Per Year

All amounts as set forth above do not include any monies attributed to citizen donations.

**Section 2. Salary Limits.** The maximum salary schedule as set forth in Section 1 above sets forth the maximum salaries payable. The Mayor shall set an employee's actual salary which may be less than the amount set forth in the schedule.

**Section 3. Repeal.** This ordinance repeals any other prior ordinance to the extent such other ordinance is in conflict with this ordinance as to any part.

**Section 4. Emergency Clause.** The City Council for the City of Cammack Village finds and determines that the appropriations for the 2012 Salaries/Holiday Policy as set forth above are essential for the orderly administration and operation of the City of Cammack Village, Arkansas and an emergency is declared to exist, and this ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety be in full force and effect on and after January 1, 2012.
