

ORDINANCE NO. 18-02

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR COLLECTION OF CITY JAIL FEE AND COUNTY JAIL FEE; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, as authorized by Cammack Village City Ordinance 17-04, Cammack Village City/District Court will continue to exist. Court will be held in the Little Rock District Court, District 31, Little Rock 3, as permitted under A.C.A. § 16-17-138; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cammack Village is authorized to levy a fee in accordance with A.C.A. § 16-17-129;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CAMMACK VILLAGE, ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1: Beginning immediately, and continuing thereafter, Cammack Village is authorized and may levy and assess a fee pursuant to A.C.A. § 16-17-129, which shall be called the jail fee, in an amount not greater than \$20.00 dollars to be paid by any person who is found guilty, pleads guilty, or pleads nolo contendere to any criminal or traffic offense in the court.

SECTION 2: Any fee imposed by this section shall be paid to the Little Rock District Court Clerk, along with any other applicable fees.

SECTION 3: Said fee and the revenue collected by the assessment of this fine may be used for the purposes set forth in A.C.A. § 16-17-129, including the following: (1) the construction, maintenance, and operation of the city, county, or regional jail; (2) deferring the costs of incarcerating prisoners held by the county, city, or any entity; (3) the transportation and incarceration of city or county prisoners; (4) the purchase and maintenance of equipment for the city, county, or regional jail.

SECTION 4: Any Ordinance or parts of ordinances that are in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent that they conflict with this Ordinance.

SECTION 5: It has been found, and it is hereby declared, by the City Council that there is an immediate need for that ordained herein; **THEREFORE**, an emergency is declared, and this Ordinance, being necessary for the preservation of public peace, health and safety, shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval.
