

ORDINANCE NO. 05-05

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING LOUD AND UNNECESSARY NOISES WITHIN THE CITY OF CAMMACK VILLAGE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Cammack Village deems it necessary and appropriate to prohibit loud and unnecessary noises within the City of Cammack Village, Arkansas.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby ordained by the City Council of the City of Cammack Village, Arkansas;

Section 1: The creation of any unreasonably loud, disturbing unnecessary noises is prohibited. Noises of such character, intensity and duration, as to be detrimental to the life or health of any individual, or in the disturbance of the public peace and welfare, is prohibited.

Section 2: The following acts, among others, are declared to be loud, disturbing and unnecessary noise:

- (a) The loud playing of radios, televisions, amplifiers, loud-speakers, musical instruments, vehicle alarm systems or other devices not enumerated here but which are plainly audible from a distance of fifty (50) feet from its source or in such manner as to annoy or disturb the quiet comfort or repose of persons in an office or residence, or of any persons in the vicinity, particularly between the hours of 10:00p.m. and 7:00a.m.
- (b) None of the terms of prohibition of this section shall be applied to or enforced against any vehicle of the City while engaged in necessary public business.

Section 3: Persons found to be in violation of this Ordinance shall be fined up to \$100.00 for each offense.

Section 4: This Ordinance repeals any prior Ordinance to the extent such other Ordinance is in conflict with this Ordinance as to any part.

Section 5: Emergency Clause: The City Council for the City of Cammack Village, finds and determines that an emergency is declared to exist, and this Ordinance being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety be in full force and effect on and after September 13, 2005.
