

ORDINANCE 07-07

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PENALTIES IMPOSED FOR NON-COMPLIANCE WITH PAYMENT OF TRASH COLLECTION FEES; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Cammack Village previously adopted Ordinance No. 06-01 which set the fees for trash collection services within the City of Cammack Village, Arkansas, established penalties for non-compliance with the ordinance and declared an emergency and for other purposes.

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to amend Ordinance No. 06-01 as follows:

SECTION 1: That Section 5 of 06-01 should read as follows:

The above-noted charges shall become due and payable at the beginning of each quarter. Such charges may be made without penalty at any time during a quarter or prior to close of the first day of the month of the next ensuing quarter. (For example, charges for the first quarter may be paid without penalty through April 1.) After the close of the first day of the month of the next ensuing quarter, a penalty of Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00) for each quarterly payment will be imposed for each quarter or portion thereof during which the payment remains unpaid. (For example, if a payment for the first quarter is not made by April 1, a penalty starts accruing on April 2).

SECTION 2: All other portions of Ordinance 06-01 shall remain in full force and effect.


SECTION 3: It is found and is hereby determined that the collection procedures for trash collection fees need to be adjusted and a more substantial penalty established. Further, it is determined that this ordinance is immediately necessary because cost of collections are becoming unduly expensive and this enactment will correct existing conditions. Now, therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance, being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety and welfare, shall be in full force and effect on January 1, 2008.


