

ORDINANCE 08-05

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING CERTAIN ANIMALS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF CAMMACK VILLAGE, ARKANSAS; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, the City of Cammack Village is a residential city in which the homes are in close proximity to one another.

WHEREAS, Cammack Village has previously banned certain dangerous animals from the City, per the terms of Ordinance no. 02-03.

WHEREAS, the City Council of Cammack Village has decided it is necessary to prohibit more animals within its city limits, as follows;

SECTION 1: It shall be unlawful for any person to keep, maintain, sell, or have in his or her possession animals which are generally considered domestic farm animals, which include, but are not limited to, horses, pigs, goats, mules, donkeys, cows, chickens and geese within the city limits of Cammack Village, Arkansas.

SECTION 2: Persons found guilty of violating this Ordinance shall be fined no more than \$100.00 per day for each violation. In addition, after a citation is issued to the person in possession of the animal, the Cammack Village City Police Department is authorized to have the animal removed from the city limits. Whatever cost is incurred shall be paid by the person in possession of the animal.

SECTION 3: All ordinances and portions of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed. Should any portion of the Ordinance be unconstitutional or invalid and be so declared by a court of competent jurisdiction, then the remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected by such partial invalidity.

SECTION 4: EMERGENCY CLAUSE: It is found and determined that possession of farm animals within the city limits of Cammack Village, Arkansas, affects the peaceful use of all property owners to enjoy their property; that it potentially devalues all property within Cammack Village; Further, it is determined that this Ordinance is immediately necessary.


NOW, THEREFORE, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance, being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety and welfare, shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
